Our service commenced in 1978 due to a group of like-minded individuals who identified there were people in our district who were not able to access their community.

Being the first Community Transport service in NSW we have been providing transport since our commencement, ensuring our community members are not isolated.

BCT is funded through the Commonwealth Home Support Program, Dept. of Family and Community Services and Community Transport Program-Transport for NSW.

BCT complies with the NSW Disability Standards

Currently, we have three wheelchair accessible Kia Carnivals, four buses, two of which are wheelchair accessible and three sedans.

SERVICES

What we offer the Bathurst community:

BCT offers a door to door service to eligible community members to get where they want to be, when they want to be there.

Destinations for transport may include:

- Individual/group social outings
- Medical appointments (hospital/doctor specialist)
- Personal appointments (hairdresser, luncheons, meetings)
- Personal activities (shopping/exercise facilities)

This program runs Monday-Friday, 7am-6pm (excluding public holidays).

BCT believes our clients have the right to independence.

We provide transport to support people to get to where they would like to go, need to go or dream to go.

We provide specialised transport options which enables our clients' ongoing participation in their community.

Our fleet of nine vehicles, five of which are wheelchair accessible, will meet the various need of our clients.

This program runs Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm

RADIATION SERVICE

Bathurst Community Transport coordinates the **Radiation Bus Service which is supported by Our Community**. This service commutes once a day **Monday-Friday, 9am** (excluding public holidays) from Daffodil Cottage, Bathurst, to the Orange Radiation Department, Orange Base Hospital.

When you are making your appointments at the Orange Radiation Department let them know you are travelling on the Radiation Bus and they will fit your appointment times in with the bus timetable.
