You've spoken, we've listened!

We have had some wonderful suggestions for social trips for 2023 which we have lined up for you over the next few months. We have also received feedback regarding the time taken to collect everyone at the start of the trips and are trialling a central pick up point for our social outings for the next few months. If you do not drive locally or cannot get to the departure point please let us know at time of booking and we will organise for you to get there in the morning and back in the afternoon at an additional cost.

Many of the venues that you have requested require payment in advance to confirm our booking. These trips are **identified by a ticket icon**. In cases where a meal is included we will request your dietary requirements at time of booking.

Unfortunately we have had numerous cancellations the day prior to or on the morning of scheduled trips. This often means others have missed out on a trip. At short notice it is often not possible to refill the seat. **We will now be taking full payment for each trip at time of booking**. If you cancel a ticketed trip after payment has been received you will be refunded only if we can refill your seat. For non-ticketed trips a \$10 cancellation fee per trip will be levied if we cannot refill your seat.

It is important to note the mobility requirements for each trip and choose trips which suit your mobility. Your safety and comfort is our priority.




